



Project reference: RNLI – Mumbles/Moelfre/Swanage

Following a successful project with BAM Nuttall to manufacture, supply and install a new slipway for the RNLI TAMAR Lifeboat at RNLI Mumbles, further orders were secured for both RNLI Moelfre and RNLI Swanage.

The additional orders were awarded based on our prior performance; delivering the slipway at Mumbles on time and within budget, this was followed by successful trials with the Lifeboat launch.

The slipways were fully constructed in Centregreat's Cardiff workshops, including the access walkways to ensure no misalignments on site during erection.

Our ability to pre-assemble reduced the amount of time spent on site and in turn reduced the costs associated with ancillary equipment including jack-up barges etc.
